Article 13 - Everyone has the right to travel within and outside their own country

Israeli checkpoints and blockades have restricted or prevented the movement of Palestinians between towns and villages in the West Bank. The Israeli security arrangements effectively denied many Palestinians of their livelihoods, and access to health care. Palestinians were barred or had limited access to over 300km of roads in the West Bank.

Article 17 - Everyone has the right to own property on their own or with others, and it cannot be taken without good cause

Palestinian homes were demolished without warning on the 11th March 2008. The Israeli Army demolished the homes in Palestinian villages in the occupied West Bank. The homes and property of the Palestinian families in the villages of Hadidiya, Jiftlik and Furush Beit Dajan, in the Jordan Valley area of the occupied West Bank, were demolished. In all these places, most of the people affected by this deliberate destruction are children.
