Article 3 - Everyone has the right to life and the right to live in freedom and safety

Since 1976, 1.099 prisoners have been executed in the US. The way has been cleared for the United States to resume executions after the Supreme Court upheld Kentucky's use of lethal injection executions. Executions had been on hold for nearly eight months.

Article 10 - Everyone has the right to a fair trial, if accused of a crime

The US has held hundreds individuals suspected of terrorism at the US Naval Base in Guantanamo Bay, Cuba without charging them with a crime. Some have been held in secret custody for up to four years prior to being transferred to Guantanamo. Without being charged with a crime, many are left with no way of challenging their detentions.
