Teachers' Notes

What can be done to make a difference?

Preparation

1. Print out extra reflection sheets as students may have forgotten their reflection sheet from the previous week.
2. Ensure each group of two has a reflection sheet.
3. Arrange for students to contact any social justice organisations that may be able to assist them in their planning.
4. Arrange to take photographs of the class engaging with the materials.

Sample activities to get you started

1. Promote the UDHR by creating a charter of rights for your class, school or centre.
2. Invite in a guest speaker - a local human rights activist or a representative from a human rights organisation.
3. Organise a campaign in your school to promote human rights. For example use notice boards around your school to put up displays which tackle bullying or arranged fights.
4. Organise a campaign in your local community to highlight a human rights injustice. For example arrange a protest or petition.
5. Celebrate the UDHR on a relevant day and sell Fair Trade items in the tuck shop or canteen or organise a day of cookery using Fair Trade ingredients.
